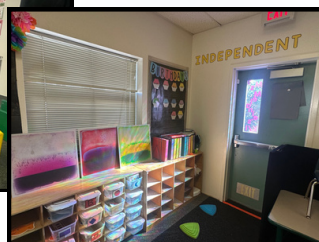
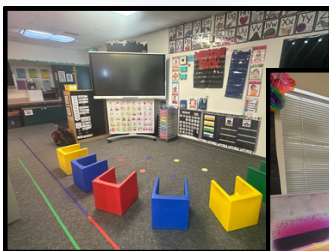


Melanie Erlichman, Year 2 Induction
